



Summer Internship Application

Purpose:

To give college and/or seminary students the opportunity to experience ministry in a real life setting. Pitts Baptist Church would like to provide experience in this area over a ten-week period during the summer break. In some instances, college credit may be earned for the experience. It is also our goal to see God call young people into full-time ministry or even confirm His call through this internship.

Responsibilities:

Early Childhood and Children's Interns are under the direction of Jennifer Brayley, Director of Children's Ministry and Amy Alley, Director of Early Childhood Ministry. **Youth Interns** are under the direction of Rev. Kevin Knight, Minister to Students. **College Interns** are under the direction of Rev. Kevin Seger, Associate Pastor. Intern responsibilities are assigned based on the assessed talents and abilities of the student.

Requirements:

- Must LOVE children/youth and be able to work and communicate with children, teens, and adults.
- A student who feels like God has called them or may be calling them into full-time vocational ministry.
- A person willing to give of themselves sacrificially for the work of the Lord.

Work schedule:

- Total of 11 weeks over May - August
- Thirty hours per week
- Hours are flexible each week depending upon specific scheduled activities

Financial Support and Benefits:

- The church will pay the intern \$200 per week for a total of ten weeks.
- One week of unpaid vacation time (Time must be approved and may not be taken during VBS or a camp week).
