Older Toddlers

Last month was all about hearts, love & even how we can show love to others. We practiced using our spoons, climbing the stairs, pulling up our pants and putting on our own shoes & jackets. You could say we’ve been rather busy!

We are paying special attention to using our words with our friends & teachers as well as learning to play cooperatively.

Please be sure there is an extra set of clothes at school and remember to take blankets home for washing on Friday.

Early Preschool A

We enjoyed learning about sports, all kinds of animals and how we can show love to others. We practiced colors & shapes and also started talking about emotions/feelings.

We are excited to begin learning about Spring! We will explore flowers, bugs and all kinds of weather. We will also be introducing some new books to celebrate Dr Seuss!

Between learning to use the potty & learning to use an open cup, we have so many spills & accidents! Please be sure there are plenty changes of clothes at school every day, and even a pair of shoes, too!

Early Preschool B

There is no shortage of imagination and dramatic play in our classroom! We have learned so much! We talked about keeping our teeth healthy and how to keep our bodies healthy, too! We talked about, searched for and formed the letters B, C, K & L.

This month we will focus on the letters D, E, M & N. We will also focus on playing cooperatively with friends. We will spend some time remembering to use good manner words, like “please,” “thank you” and “excuse me.”

Preschool A

In February, we learned about germs and keeping ourselves and others healthy. We chomped into Dental Health keeping our teeth healthy. We then rounded out the month talking about presidents. We are excited to celebrate Dr. Seuss’ birthday. We are also looking forward to having the grandparents come in and read to us. We will be exploring creepy crawly insects, discovering and exploring rocks and earth worms, welcoming spring and digging right into flowers and gardening.

We will be introducing letters S, T, U & V. We are in the midst of our Dr. Seuss Spirit Week. We are having a blast! WE are continuing to work on our proper hand washing and sneezing or coughing into our elbow to “catch” the germs.

Preschool B

Last month, we learned all about how to forgive as Jesus has forgiven us, how to serve others, and we are beginning to study in Genesis about how God made all things and “It was good”.

The kids get so excited about learning and writing their names and doing so well at tackling that task. We learned all about taking care of our teeth, dinosaurs, bugs and germs.

In March, we will continue our Bible story about all the beautiful things God has created. The kids are learning so much about how to become more independent. We are encouraging the children to put away some of their meal time items (cup, spoons, and containers). They are so proud of themselves as are we. We will continue practice letter recognition and letter writing. Our themed this month will revolve around Spring!

Pre-Kindergarten A

We had so much fun at our Valentine party! Thank you all for contributing to the goodies. In February, we learned about 3-D shapes, healthy eating and what we put on their shopping lists. The children had fun working together building and putting together puzzles.

In March, we will continue working on letter recognition and objects that begin with x, y, and z. We will also continue working on number families and recognizing numbers. We will do more tracing and cutting out shapes as well as writing their names. We are really excited about the book fair next week! Parents, please make sure your child has a coat because we do go outside every day. Also, please make sure your child has multiple changes of clothes.

Pre-Kindergarten B

February was full of exciting activities. Learning how to take care of our bodies and teeth was so much fun. Celebrating Valentine's Day and showing love to others and God was the highlight of February. In March, we will finish the letters of the alphabet. Also, we will introduce color words and number words. Our reading circles are so much fun. Working on our blends has helped us learn new words. We will learn to count to 100 by 5's and work on before and after numbers. Our handwriting has improved immensely. Our themes this month are Dr. Seuss, Life in Bible Times, and When the Winds Blow. We are looking forward to Spring and warmer weather. Please remember to check your child's folder daily. Also, make sure to clean out your child's cubby weekly.

In February, we made our way toward the end of our study of Romans. We enjoyed the excitement of a small snow but keeping our fingers crossed for more in March!
